## **PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

### Special General Meeting

On Saturday 11 June 2022 at 12 o'clock sharp the Special General Meeting was held in the Clubrooms with 12 financial members in attendance.

*MOTION - That the financial members of the Rotorua Fishing and Casting Club Inc give authority to the Committee of the Rotorua Fishing and Casting Club Inc, to transfer \$28,000 from the Term Deposit Building Fund to the Rotorua Fishing and Casting Club Operating Account.*

The Motion was passed unanimously. *Motion carried with the following amendment:*

*Any funds remaining following the clubroom improvements and purposes will be returned to the Term Deposit Building Fund by the August 2023 AGM.*

A full Financial Report was presented by the Treasurer and myself to the members who attended the meeting. This report covered the period from now up to the 54th Bonanza, which covered all expenses of the renovations, boundary adjustment, AGM and prizegiving, 54th Bonanza, and the general running of the Club.

### Boundary Adjustment

The Club has had a lot of movement from the Surveyor regarding this matter. The Surveyor has finally finished the plans and has applied for a

Code of Compliance with the Whakatane District Council. These plans have been sent to the Clubs Lawyers who are waiting for the Code of Compliance to be approved. The Lawyers then send the plans to the Registrar of Lands for the final stamp of approval.

### Renovations

The renovations are in full swing. The kitchen cabinets have been removed and the new floor has been installed. All the wallpaper has been steamed off the walls and walls have been Plastered. The Plumber fixed a leak under the Clubrooms which was picked up when installing the floors, and ready the pipes for the new kitchen sink. The Electrician has relocated a couple of power sockets and a light switch.

There was a Working Bee on Saturday 25 June to paint the inside of the Clubrooms another held on 2 July to finish off and to touch up any mishaps.

Hopefully, the flat-pack kitchen will be delivered by the middle of July but will let all know that date. The Committee at the moment is looking for a lino layer to lay the lino in the kitchen, so if you know anyone who will lay the Lino for cash, for the Club, please let the Secretary or myself know as it would be much appreciated.
